



Cranbuddies Preschool Program

The Cranbury School District is offering two integrated preschool programs for the 2010-2011 school year. **Three year old typically developing children** are welcome to attend the Cranbuddies program on Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings. The three-year old class also includes children who require a special education program. The class is taught by a teacher certified for Early Childhood Development and Special Education and a Teacher Assistant. Four typically developing children will be accepted into the morning program. In order to be considered for acceptance, a child must be a Cranbury resident and eligible for kindergarten in September 2012. Tuition for the year is \$2,250 and transportation for the typically developing children is the responsibility of the parent.

The Cranbuddies **four-year-old program** will meet five afternoons a week. The class is co-taught by a teacher certified for Early Childhood Development and Special Education, a teacher certified for Early Childhood Education and Elementary Education, and a Teacher Assistant. Eight typically developing children will be accepted into the program, which also includes children with special needs. In order to be considered for acceptance, a child must be a Cranbury resident and eligible for kindergarten in September 2011. Tuition for the year is \$3,000 and transportation for the typically developing children is the responsibility of the parent.

If you are a Cranbury resident interested in finding out more about the Cranbuddies preschool program, please attend the **Open House on Wednesday, February 17, 2010** in room 11 of the Cranbury School. The **four-year-old program** will be discussed from **5:00-6:00 pm** and the **three-year-old program** will be discussed from **6:00-7:00 pm**. Applications and program fliers will be available at that time and will also be available in the Child Study Team Office beginning on February 17th. A deposit fee of \$100 is required and **applications are due no later than Monday, March 8, 2010**.

In case of **inclement weather**, the Open House will be rescheduled to **Thursday, February 24, 2010**. For additional information, please call the child study team office at 395-1700 extension 232. Parents of preschoolers who may be in need of special education services are also encouraged to contact the child study team for further information regarding the preschool program. If eligible, the program is available to special needs preschoolers at no cost to the parent and transportation is provided.
